These simple wooden planks encourage open-ended play by combining to build everything from spiders and snakes to skyscrapers, trains, and rocket ships.

Family friendly activities

Each week of the Family Fun Festival follows a different theme, but the huge tubs of Citiblocs wooden planks will be available for Millennium Park visitors to play with all summer. A corner of the Family Fun Tent is set aside to make space for parents, grandparents, caregivers, and kids to work together to create block masterpieces.

Although Citiblocs blocks are versatile enough that aspiring young builders can create interesting structures with even just a few planks, the possibilities that open up once kids have access to hundreds and thousands of planks are amazing.
