The blocks are made out of pine and are very lightweight. Since they are all the exact same size they are easy to build with. The package of [Citiblocs](#) comes with a little booklet with pictures of different things you can build- great for giving us some ideas of things to make.

Every precision-cut pine piece is exactly the same shape and size and it's surprisingly lightweight. The wooden blocks, crafted in Vietnam from New Zealand trees, don't require glue, snaps, or connectors. Big and little kids simply supply gravity, balance, imagination and a flat surface! Imaginative kids can open the box and make a castle, then create a whole kingdom. Knock it down for a swirly skyscraper or a big wooden creature. Ideal for children ages 3 and up, grownups like to play with them too! While busy building, balancing and designing, tykes can learn the basics of architecture, mathematics and science.
